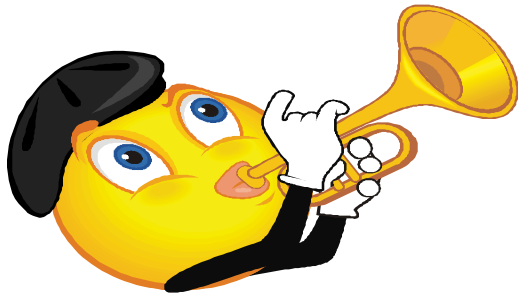


Greetings,

Do you remember the old MPC Zingers? Round 2 Corp. is re-releasing all the old Zingers, from the Super Volks Zingers to the Little Red Zinger. These are 1/43 scale bodies with 1/20 scale motors and wheels. They will have “retro deluxe” features: mini display box and NEW decal sheet!

Then, as if just the release wasn't enough to blow your socks off, Round 2 Corp. is issuing these same models in a Special Edition, too!!!

For those of you who haven't heard yet, Estes Corporation has been sold to Hobbico, one of the largest hobby suppliers in the country. Hobbico also got Sterling Models and Cox Models in the deal with Estes, who had purchased both these companies several years ago. Not much of the Cox Models' line, and none of the Sterling products have been available for some time. Hobbico has indicated that they may bring back some of these products in the near future. What you will see fairly soon, is the production of the Estes' Classic Line that they promised a year or so ago. Watch our shelves for the newest releases of the Estes Rockets - just in time for the Spring Launching Season.

Speaking of Spring, we just got in some real cool foam and rubber band flying planes. The F-16 Fighting Falcon Thunderbird glider is catapult-powered, made of foam and can be assembled in just a few minutes. I put one together, and have catapulted it into just about every snow flake hanging from our ceiling. It has a rubber "nose", so I haven't broken it yet! (The snowflakes, though, look like some giant animal has been gnawing on them!) The Giant Sky Rover Flyer can be made into a biplane or a monoplane and it rubber powered. Lots of fun --- even on these snow-filled days -- indoors and out!
